

## THEMENPOOLS – ENGLISCH (8AB)

The oral English matura consists of a 5-minute monologue and a 10-minute paired activity, each on one of the topics listed below.

The student should be able to<sup>1</sup>:

- present clear, detailed descriptions and presentations on a wide range of subjects related to his/her field of interest expanding and supporting ideas with subsidiary points and relevant examples.
- have a sufficient range of language to be able to give clear descriptions, express viewpoints on most general topics, without much conspicuous searching for words, using some complex sentence forms to do so.
- show a relatively high degree of grammatical control.
- avoid errors which cause misunderstanding, and can correct most of his/her mistakes.
- produce stretches of language with a fairly even tempo; although he/she can be hesitant as he or she searches for patterns and expressions, there are few noticeably long pauses.
- initiate discourse, take his/her turn when appropriate and end conversation when he / she needs to, though he /she may not always do this elegantly.
- help the discussion along on familiar ground confirming comprehension, inviting others in, etc.
- use a limited number of cohesive devices to link his/her utterances into clear, coherent discourse, though there may be some "jumpiness" in a long contribution.
- develop a clear argument, expanding and supporting his/her points of view at some length with subsidiary points and relevant examples.
- construct a chain of reasoned arguments and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.
- communicate spontaneously, often showing remarkable fluency and ease of expression in even longer complex stretches of speech.
